

## Chapter 1.12

### PUBLICIZING OF ORDINANCES

#### Sections:

**1.12.010** **Posting-- Required.** All ordinances of the City shall henceforth be printed and posted in at least two public places within the City as the City Council may direct from time to time. (Ord. 773, December 2003; Ord. 399 SI (part), 1981.)

**1.12.020** **Posting--Length of period.** The ordinances as referred to in Section 1.12.010 shall be posted for a minimum of fifteen days excluding the day first posted and shall be in full force and effect after they have been posted for a period of five days excluding the date first posted whereupon the city clerk shall prepare a certificate under seal of a notary public attesting to the publication of the ordinance by posting and attaching the original of the certification to the ordinance upon its filing after publication. **1.12.030** **Posting --Where.** The City Clerk shall post all ordinances of the City following their enactment at the following public places within the City:

- A. City Hall; and
- B. Public library. (Ord. 773, December 2003; Ord. 399, S1 (part), 1981.)

**1.12.040** **Publication of ordinances.** Properly after adoption, a summary of the content of each ordinance passed by the City Council shall be published at least once in a designated newspaper of general circulation within the City. (Ord. 773, December 2003; Ord. 399 S1 (part).)
