VEHICLE WEIGHT

10.08.010 Definitions. "Licensed gross vehicle weight" means the gross weight set by the licensee in his application for a license and as marked on the vehicle. If the vehicle is not licensed based on gross vehicle weight, the vehicle's actual scaled gross vehicle weight shall be defined as the licensed gross vehicle weight. The licensed gross vehicle weight shall apply whether the vehicle is carrying its maximum load or any portion thereof. (Ord. 394 S1 (part), 1981.)

10.08.020 Restrictions. No person shall operate or otherwise cause to be driven, towed, pushed or drawn over or upon the streets, highways, or alleys of the city any motor vehicle, trailer or combination thereof with a licensed gross vehicle weight in excess of twenty thousand pounds. (Ord. 394 S1 (part), 1981.)

10.08.030 Exceptions. All motor vehicles, trailers, or combinations thereof shall be exempt from the provisions of this Chapter if:

- A. They are operated on designated truck routes which include:
 - 1. Horne Drive;
 - 2. Babs Avenue;
 - 3. 7th Street;
 - 4. 13th Street;
 - 5. Dale Avenue West of 13th Street;
 - 6. Ki-Be Road; and
 - 7. Any other roadway designated as a truck route by appropriate signage.
- B. For the purpose of:
 - 1. To deliver or pick up materials, merchandise or passengers within the territorial limits of the City; or
 - 2. To provide or secure service, repair or to respond to a public emergency within the territorial limits of the City. (Ord. 923, 2013; Ord. 394 S1 (part), 1981.)
