5.08.010 **Category A.** The license fee for Category A business license is set by the most current resolution entitled "City Fee Schedule". Category A licenses shall include, but are not limited to, the following or similar business activities:

Auctions, banks, and financial institutions, dray and transfer, motel, hotel, and cabin courts, recreational vehicle parks, theaters, charitable and religious solicitors, cafes, and restaurants, retail stores, used furniture stores, antiques, apartments and commercial rentals, professions including physicians, surgeons, dentists, lawyers and accountants, service stations, body and fender repair shops, lumberyards and real estate offices. (Ord. 619, April 1995.)

5.08.020 **Category B.** The license fee for Category B business license is set by the most current resolution entitled "City Fee Schedule". Category B licenses shall include, but are not limited to, the following or similar business activities:

Private detectives, taverns, places of liquor sale, dealers in salvage and junk, pawn shops, places of amusement, amusement devices, peddlers, assemblies, tow trucks, pool halls, building and construction contractors, and dancehalls. (Ord. 619, April 1995.)

5.08.030 **Category C.** The license fee for Category C business licenses is set by the most current resolution entitled "City Fee Schedule". Category C licenses shall include, but are not limited to, the following or similar business activities:

Vehicles for hire, parades and demonstrations, private or public utilities, cable television, and telephone companies. (Ord. 619, April 1995.)

5.08.040 **Multiple businesses.** In the case of multiple businesses where more than one of any of the businesses for which a license is required is carried on by the same person in the same location, the license fee shall be higher than the Category B and Category C license fees, and said fee shall be set by the most current resolution entitled "City Fee Schedule." (Ord. 619, April 1995.)
