## OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN CITY PARKS, TRAILWAYS AND BIKE PATHS PROHIBITED

<u>8.07.010</u>	Operation of Motor Vehicles Prohibited. No person may operate a motorcycle, motor bike, motor vehicle, or any motorized vehicle powered by an internal combustion engine of any type within the limits of any City park, City bike path or City trailway. This section shall not prohibit the operation of said vehicles in a lawful manner along any street or road regularly established by the City within said parks for the purpose of moving motor vehicles.
8.07.020	<b>Applicability of Prohibition.</b> This prohibition does not include motorized equipment used in the maintenance and upkeep of City parks, bike paths or trailways, and shall not apply to any vehicle used by disabled person as

<u>8.07.030</u> <u>Violations – Fine</u>. Any person found to be in violation of the provisions of this Chapter shall be deemed to have committed a civil infraction, and for each violation, shall be subject to a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). (Ord. 850, January 2009)
