ORDINANCE NO. 923

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BENTON CITY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 10.080.030 "EXCEPTIONS" REGARDING VEHICLE WEIGHT TO EXCLUDE TRUCK ROUTES

WHEREAS, the City has restricted vehicles in excess of 20,000 pounds being operated on City streets for the protection or preservation of those streets; and

WHEREAS, since the enactment of this Section, truck routes have been designated within the City which need to be excluded from this restriction. NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENTON CITY, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Section 10.08.030 entitled "Exceptions" of the Benton City Municipal Code shall be and hereby is amended and shall read as follows:

- <u>10.08.030</u> Exceptions. All motor vehicles, trailers, or combinations thereof shall be exempt from the provisions of this Chapter if the same be operated for any of the following purposes:
 - A. They are operated on designated truck routes which includes:
 - 1. Horne Drive;
 - Babs Avenue;
 - 3. 7th Street;
 - 4. 13th Street;
 - 5. Dale Avenue West of 13th Street;
 - 5. Ki-Be Road; and
 - 6. Any other roadway designated as a truck route by appropriate signage.

AB. For the purpose of:

- A<u>1</u>. To deliver or pick up materials, merchandise or passengers within the territorial limits of the City; or
- <u>B2</u>. To provide or secure service, repair or to respond to a public emergency within the territorial limits of the City. (Ord. 394 S1 (part), 1981.)

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall take full force and effect five (5) days after its approval, passage and publication as required by law.
