

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-10**

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING APRIL 20, 2013, AS  
"BEAR ATTACK DAY"**

**WHEREAS**, promoting unity between the community of Benton City and the Kiona-Benton City Schools will encourage a positive atmosphere in which children and youth can be nurtured; and

**WHEREAS**, visible representations of community and school pride will serve to remind residents and visitors that Benton City is a "town of choice" for families in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, Ki-Be Pride flags have been purchased and paint has been donated to adorn the city with symbols of community pride; and

**WHEREAS**, Bear Attack Day projects are being organized by the leaders of Ki-Be High School ASB and these leaders are encouraging participation in said projects by students and community members; and

**WHEREAS**, Bear Attack Day projects are being supported by Kiona-Benton City School District, BCFPD No. 2, Benton City Special Event Planning Committee, Vineyard City Arts Council, Benton City Chamber of Commerce, Benton City Economic Development Council, NRG and Big Print Shop, Ki-Be High School ASB, Ki-Be metal shop and woodshop teachers and students, and many community-minded citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, citizens of Benton City have an opportunity to participate in installation of Ki-Be Pride symbols throughout our city on Bear Attack Day, April 20, 2013, as well as create and implement community beautification and pride promotion projects where they identify the need;

**WHEREAS**, a community celebration is appropriate to commemorate the efforts to emphasize encouragement of Ki-Be Pride; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENTON CITY, WASHINGTON**, hereby resolves as follows:

Lloyd R. Carnahan, Mayor of the City of Benton City, does hereby proclaim April 20, 2013, as Bear Attack Day to be a day of celebration in Benton City, and call upon the people of Benton City to participate in community pride promotion projects and to celebrate community pride with appropriate ceremonies on Bear Attack Day and throughout the year to acknowledge Ki-Be Pride spirit.


